

Evaluation Guidelines for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair, Academia Sinica

Drafted on February 18, 2005; Approved on February 22, 2005

Amended on December 26, 2007; Approved on January 14, 2008

Article 1

The funding for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair is donated by the China Foundation for the Promotion of Education and Culture (15,000 US Dollars per year).

Article 2

The Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair is held once per year. The grant is given to one person each time. (The grant may not be given to the same person twice.)

Article 3

The research area of candidates for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair shall be in the humanities and social sciences.

Article 4

The candidates for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair must be full-time associate research fellows or above of Academia Sinica.

Article 5

Grant recipients of the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair shall be evaluated by the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee.

Article 6

Candidates for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair may submit applications in person or be recommended by the research institutes, preparatory offices, or research centers in the humanities and social sciences of Academia Sinica, or recommended by the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee of Academia Sinica. (The guidelines for the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee, Academia Sinica were approved by the President of Academia Sinica on January 14, 2008, as attached) The applicant shall provide a curriculum vitae, a list of academic publications, a research plan and three representative publications. Applications are received at the beginning of each year.

Article 7

Upon receiving the applications, the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee shall provide a list of reviewers to the Academic Affairs Office. Once the Academic Affairs

Office finishes conducting its evaluations, the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee shall conduct a second review and decide on the grant recipient.

Article 8

The grant recipient is obliged to serve as speaker of the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair the following year.

Article 9

These guidelines are drafted by the Dr. Hu Shih Memorial Chair Committee. These guidelines and the amendments thereof shall take effect as of the date of their approval by the President of Academia Sinica.
